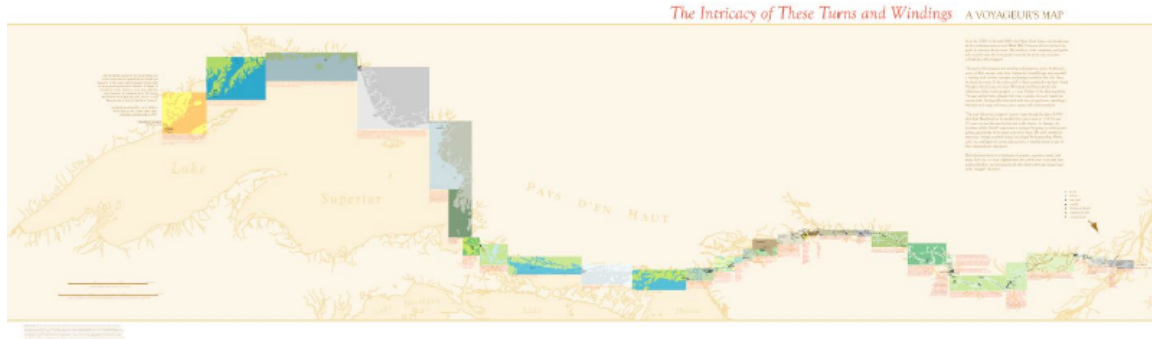

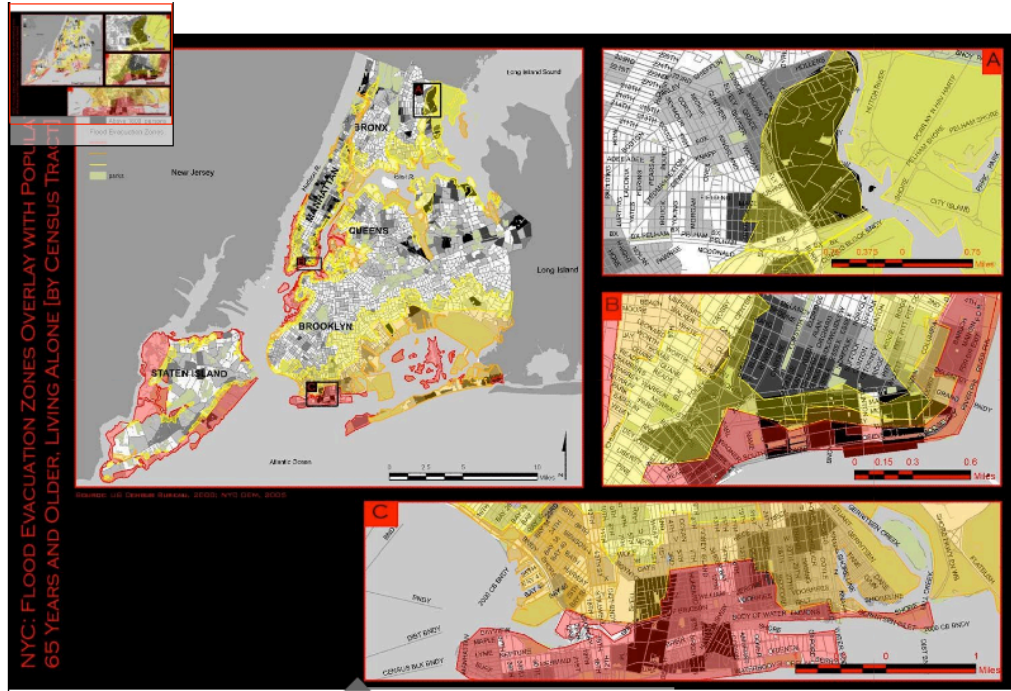


New York City: Flood Surge Evacuation Zones

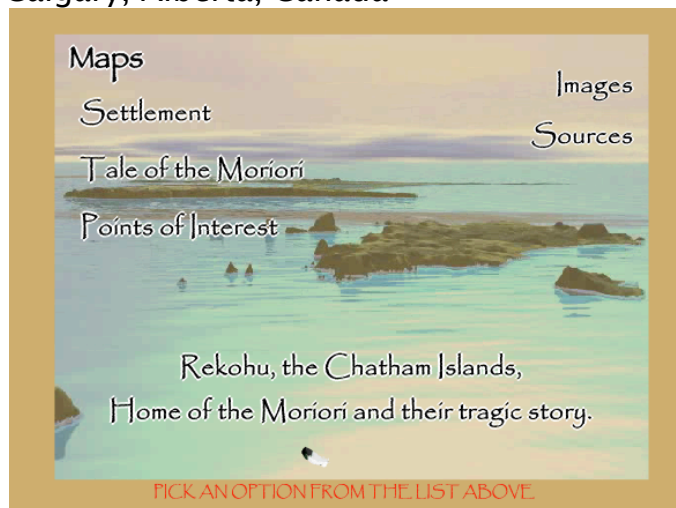
